Water supply shut down: Saturday 14th August (overnight)

Macleay and Lamb Islands

Seqwater have been working to install a replacement pipeline between Macleay and Lamb Islands following a recent leak.

To complete the installation of a new pipeline, Seqwater must temporarily turn off the water supply. People living on Macleay and Lamb Islands will have low or no water supply overnight. This will be restored once work is complete on Sunday morning.



Water supply will be shut off on Saturday 14th August from 7.30pm.

Water supply is expected to be restored Sunday morning.

What to expect:

- This work will be completed at night when water use is lowest.
- Work crews will be moving about the islands in utility vehicles in the days before the shut down, with an increase in traffic on 14th August.
- Seqwater contractors will be bringing fittings to site and getting ready before the shut down to minimise the duration of the disruption.
- Because the work will be conducted at night, lighting will be in place and noise will be more noticeable, particularly around Cressy Street, Macleay Island.

We are committed to minimising the impacts of this project for residents and businesses and will keep you up to date. We appreciate your understanding as we work to maintain our critical water infrastructure.

How to prepare for the shut down



Before the shut down, fill your available water containers with drinking water to have in the fridge or available during the night.



You can fill your bathtub with water to use for flushing toilets only.



Once the water supply is returned, there may be some air in your pipes or some discoloured water when you first turn on your tap. Just let the water run for 2-3 minutes to clear. Your water will be safe to drink.



If you usually have an evening shower, ensure you have it before 7.30pm on Saturday 14 August.

For community alerts, weather and warning updates; opt in to receive Redland City Council's emergency messaging. Visit disaster.redland.qld.gov.au and click on the blue 'Opt-In Notifications' button.
