Update: South West Pipeline Project - June 2024 edition

Comdain Infrastructure (part of the Service Stream Group), on behalf of Seqwater, is constructing the South West Pipeline (SWP), which will connect Beaudesert to the SEQ Water Grid.

Progress to date

In May we completed the majority of works along the pipeline, including pipe repair at Mount Lindesay Highway, v-drain works and reinstatement. The fibre optic cable connection was completed from the Wyaralong Transfer Station (WTS) to Helen Street Storage, Beaudesert.

Along Bushland Road we completed the majority of construction on roadside drains, topsoiling and turfing, as well as commenced the final pavement layer for the new sealed road. Causeway construction was also completed with works to the v-drain well underway.

At the WTS, final landscaping has progressed and the site connected to live power. The project is now preparing for commissioning activities.

We are pleased with the progress made in the month of May and remain committed to delivering a successful project.

Upcoming works

The following works are planned for June:

- Sealing of Bushland Road and the WTS site.
- Shotcrete concreting works on the eastern side of the drain at the causeway on Bushland Road.
- General construction activities, movement of plant and equipment and site testing works.
- Ongoing works at the WTS site.

There will be no disruption to your water or wastewater services as a result of construction works.

Our standard work hours are between 6.30am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday, and 7.00am and 6.00pm Saturday. Some out of hours work may be necessary and impacted residents will be notified directly, following the relevant authority approvals. The site will be protected by full-time security surveillance during nighttime.

There is traffic control present along the road alignment, and you may experience some delays when travelling between Teviot Road, Flagstone and Helen Street, Beaudesert. Please be courteous to our hard-working traffic control team who are there to keep you safe and allow additional travel time when using these roads.

During work hours you may notice an increase in construction noise, dust, personnel onsite and additional vehicle movements in the local area. Work is being staged to minimise impacts to landowners and the local community. We have safety and environmental measures in place to reduce impacts and the scheduled June work is subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.
