Background

We sometimes receive requests to use the open space for aircraft and recreational craft operations, including take off and landing.

Policy position

The impact these craft can have on visitor amenity is significant and there is high potential for conflict and incidents. As such, a person is prohibited from using catchments lands, lakes and designated recreation areas to take off or land aircraft unless it is in response to emergency situations.

Aircraft and recreational craft include:

- Aeroplanes
- Amphibious aircraft
- Ultralight aircraft
- Helicopters
- Hot Air Balloons
- Hang Gliders and Paragliders.
